“One day Jesus was praying in a certain place. When He finished, one of His disciples said to Him, ‘Lord, teach us to pray...’” (Luke 11:1)



And forgive us our sins, as we forgive those who have sinned against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen.

(Matthew 6:9-13)


“OUR FATHER WHICH ART IN HEAVEN...”

He brings me peace no matter what I go through.


King

God heals all our diseases.



“What you should be thinking about is God’s kingdom. Then He will give you all these other things you need.” (Luke 12:31 ERV)


“...GIVE US THIS DAY OUR


