- 99% Muslim Government | ~ 70-80% Muslim pop. | 2.5% Bible Believing Christians
- National language: Amharic | Village languages: Mostly Oromo & Some Somali
- English by some staff at hotel, church staff and a few in the city

- Get to the airport 2.5 hours earlier than flight

- From Addis to Dire Dawa | 727 | 50 minutes
- From Dire Dawa airport to hotel: 10 minutes

# **Medications**

- 1. Your prescription meds
- 2. Malaria Pills 100 mg Doxycycline / Malarone
- 3. Cipro 500mg for traveler's Diarrhea (if needed)
- 4. Benadryl for any allergy or sleep (if needed)
- 5. Xanax for sleeplessness and calm stomach (if needed)

## <u>COVID</u>

If you are not vaccinated, you have to have a negative covid test accordingly.

- Negative PCR done up to 72 hours or 3 days before departure.
- Negative antigen up to 24 hours before arriving
- If you are not vaccinated, speak to leadership about contingency plan should you test positive while in Ethiopia


# Project Hope: Why?

In January 2012, Cornerstone began a dream with our sister church, Living Word Believer's International Church, in Dire Dawa, Ethiopia. *We acted* to create an American non-profit to fund a free-service Christian clinic for the strategic Muslim village of Gendetesfa on the outskirts of that city. The village was the poorest of the poor and had approximately 25,000 Muslims, no church, limited water, and wide-spread leprosy & constant disease. Ironically, the name Gendetesfa means "Village of **Hope**."

Our vision is for the clinic to be the gateway for every part of the body of Christ (teachers, businessmen, engineers, moms, medical personnel, athletes, media professionals, etc.) **to actively** love every part of Gendetesfa (health, education, economics, sports, friendship, etc.) so that Jesus Christ may be seen as the true savior and transformer of that village and that witness will become a "sign and a wonder" to the surrounding Muslim world. We do that through: Health Clinic, **O**rphan & Needy Childcare, **P**rimary Education, **E**conomic Development.

# Project Hope: What?

Christ's love *in action* changes things! This Christian clinic is embraced by this all Muslim village. The clinic has sees over 30,000 patients. Infectious disease has gone down 20% since the clinic opened. Active leprosy has been eradicated!!! Better yet, the Gospel has been shared over 5,000 times and over 200 people have accepted Christ! There is now an underground church in the village comprised of converted Muslims!!!! It costs approximately \$30 per patient visit and approximately \$400 to keep the clinic open for a day. Consider sponsoring a day for the clinic. The clinic's annual budget is approximately \$90,000.



## Nation: Ethiopia

- Third World Nation / Leader of Africa / Stability
- Roughly: 35% Muslim, 20% Evangelical, 40% Orthodox
- Very few Orthodox "Christians" are actually saved
- Surrounded by nations with strong Muslim movements

## City: Dire Dawa (deer-a-dow-a)

- ✤ 500,000+ people
- Total Muslim government
- ✤ 70-80%% Muslim
- 15-25% Ethiopian Orthodox
- ✤ 3% Christian
  ✤ 150+ mosques / 40 churches
- ✤ "Queen City Of The Desert" ♦ Mass Public evangelism prohibited
- 35% Somali Muslim & 35% Oromo Muslim (unreached)

- v Last stable area for local church before Islamic East
- ✤ 30 miles from the 4<sup>th</sup> most holy city of Islam, Harrar
- About 90 miles away from Somalia, Djibouti and Yemen

#### Village: Gendetesfa (gen-da-tes-fa)

- 25,000 mostly Muslim people
- No public church, two mosques
- Poorest area of Dire Dawa
  Outskirts of city
- Plagued with leprosy, disease, poverty
- \$2/day avg. income & costs \$3.50/day for family of four to eat
- Many choose between medicines or their daily meal
