Elijah House – Thorough understanding and application of Elijah House principles					
Elijah House – Opening Prayer					
Elijah House – Discipling of ministry recipient in laws of God and how they are impacting life					
Elijah House – Minister under covering of the church					
Elijah House – Ability to track from fruit to root					
Elijah House – Allowing person to draw conclusions about issues by asking questions, not by telling, unless absolutely necessary					
Elijah House – Always looking for Inner Vows that follow Bitter Root Judgements					
Elijah House – Encouraging forgiveness					
Elijah House – Praying prayers of resurrection life					
Elijah House – Only praying through what the Holy Spirit leads to in the session, reserving other observed issues for future ministry					
General Ministry – Seek to build up strong team with prayer ministry partner					
General Ministry – Ability to listen to ministry recipient and put at ease					
General Ministry – Pray ahead of time for ministry recipient and for God's heart for them					
General Ministry – Do not begin ministry unless person's story has been heard. Intervene when encountering rehearsal.					
General Ministry – Respecting personal boundaries of ministry recipient.					
General Ministry – Not touching ministry recipient unless they have given permission					
General Ministry – Balanced use of personal testimonies to encourage hope in recipient					



General Ministry – Talking should always reflect prayer, healing principles for discipleship, related healing stories for encouragement					
General Ministry – Encouraging the ministry recipient to personally hear from the Lord (Listening prayer). Teach how, when necessary.					
General Ministry – Not leading recipient in pre-supposed direction but following the Holy Spirit					
General Ministry – Using ONLY Isa 61 /Pastor’s approved ministry tools: EH, Theophostic, CHM, Biblical Foundations of Freedom					
General Ministry – Avoid advice giving					
General Ministry – Never give prophetic words using “The Lord told me or showed me. . .” Only ask if what you are getting means anything to them or you may say, “This is what I think the Lord is showing me.”					
General Ministry – Save prophetic thoughts until end of session					
General Ministry – Give appropriate homework for issues addressed					
General Ministry – Never openly judge any person being discussed in the prayer room					
General Ministry – Encourage participation in small group					
General Ministry – Be willing to recommend to other more experienced ministers when appropriate					
General Ministry – Do not allow calling at home					
General Ministry – Use any triggering of yourself during sessions as a signal to seek personal healing					
General Ministry – Never encourage recipient to give up prescribed medications					
General Ministry – Turn off cell phones before ministry					
General Ministry – If ministering in a male/female unmarried team in the evening when church is empty, please discuss session outside in parking lot. This is put in place to assure no appearance of evil.					
General Ministry – utilize outside, non-Isa 61 ministry opportunities if needed; IE. DID, severe trauma					
General Ministry – When mentoring students, allow time for discussion time after sessions					
General Ministry – End in closing prayer
