Grasp is firm now.

Many times, people never wanted to be born. They perceived the world as unsafe and never wanted to come forth. Ask if they are able to ask Jesus to help him to choose life.

Ask gently if the person can see or feel the Lord. It may be through a bright light or a feeling of peace. Allow time for Jesus to receive him/her into His hands so the first touch the person feels is His touch of strength, gentleness, warmth, security, and safety.

Allow quiet time so that hopefully the person will see or feel Jesus' presence. Let Jesus' face be the first face he ever sees, and let Jesus' voice be the first voice he ever hears

You may ask the person at this point: "Are you willing to be born? To these parents? For Jesus' sake? It is good to have prayer for the healing of any fear or pain of birth the person may have experienced.

Pray to release the person from any guilt in the mother's pain. "Jesus was there to deliver you; you were bonded to Him. Look into His loving eyes and feel His love for you." (If the person can, they may relate what they saw or felt happening in the birth scene.)

[Note: If the person was not a full-term baby, stop before the ninth month and revise as the Holy Spirit leads. No matter what kind of birth it was – normal with head first, breach birth, head wrapped with umbilical cord, Cesarean Section, instrument birth, Rh blood factor complication – God's presence can take the fear of birth away. If the newborn child was ill or in an incubator, or mother was ill, and so the child was separated from the mother for some time, had surgery, or any other additional trauma, let Jesus meet these needs.]
