

Following Jesus is always a dynamic combination of the supernatural work of God and our practical obedience.

God gives us vision that demands we grow as followers of Christ and calls us to surrender our lives in greater ways.

God's ALL IN vision for us this year is to truly make more and deeper disciples and invest in our church home and structures to help our family reach the lost. Practically, this means (1) building the outdoor pavilion, (2) new kids hallway, and (3) completing online studio system.

Our current budget doesn't include these three projects, but we want to be ALL IN seeking God together to Equip, Engage and Expand His Kingdom. In 2022 it will require our giving increasing from \$1.45 to \$2 million to accomplish everything God has called us to.

Growth is a noun to describe the act or process of growing, developing, or **becoming** gradually. God leads us to growth by leading us to learn to trust and give in greater ways. So part of church discipleship is learning to grow in giving for His mission **in our day and community.**

Remember this: "Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously. Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver."

THE HARVEST IS

To be more like Jesus is to give like He gives. Jesus said in Mark 10:45 that He did not come to be served but to serve and GIVE his life as a ransom for many. That is the end goal for you and me - to give our lives for God in such a way that thousands more come to know Him and be saved by Him.

It's time to be ALL IN with our lives. Your time, talents and treasures are needed like never before! Look at our world! There has never been a more important time to reach our community in order that the next generation would **be saved** and **delivered from the pain of a God-less life.**

On October 24th you will be invited to make a ONE year ALL IN COMMITMENT. We believe God will reveal to you the ONE number that will represent your total, radical, sacrificial generosity to the Kingdom FOR THE harvest that is before us. You become more passionate to be on mission with Jesus and to see His Gospel and church reach the lost. He enables you to give more for the Kingdom.


"What does God want me to do with His treasure in me?" You end up here, tithing the first 10% as your way to live out Jesus is first every day. Your foundation is set.



HOW TO USE THIS STUDY GUIDE

Familiarize yourself with these sections. Some of the Appendices will be used in the sessions themselves.

- 2. This is much more than a small group study guide. It has been designed as a constant companion for the ALL IN Initiative. What we do in worship, the messages we hear, and every aspect of our life together as The Cornerstone family will be guided by this study guide during the coming weeks.
- **3.** If you are hosting or co-hosting a small group, check out cornerstone.ag/allin. You will find some encouragement and help so you can avoid common obstacles to effective small groups.
- **4.** Use this study guide as an advisor. If the group responds to the lesson in an unexpected, but honest way, go with that. If you think of a better question than the next one in the lesson, ask it.
- **5.** Enjoy your small group experience. Have fun.
- **6.** Pray before each session—for your group members, for your time together, and for wisdom and insight.
- **7.** Read the outline for each session on pages 30-31 so that you understand how the sessions will flow.



A TYPICAL GROUP SESSION FOR THE ALL IN STUDY WILL INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING SECTIONS:



ABOUT THIS SESSION. Each lesson opens with a brief thought that will help you prepare for the session and get you thinking about the particular subject you will explore with your group. Make it a practice to read these before the session.

SERMON NOTES. We will provide a study guide for you each Sunday to take notes during the sermon in the provided blanks. The sermon will connect directly with your small group lesson.

COME TOGETHER. The foundation for spiritual growth is an intimate connection with God and God's family. You build that connection by sharing your experience with a few people who really know you and who earn your trust. This is helpful preparation for being able to share what Christ has done in your life with anyone you meet—which is what a disciple is ready to do. This section includes some simple questions to get you talking—letting you share as much or as little of your story as you feel comfortable doing.

WATCH THE VIDEO. When the study directs you to, you'll start the video and watch a short teaching segment. You can watch the videos online at cornerstone.ag/ALLin. Each session's teaching will include biblical insights from Pastor Shawn and interaction with brothers and sisters about aspects of the ALL IN life.

LEARN TOGETHER. In this section, you'll have an opportunity to read a passage of Scripture and discuss both the teaching and the text. You won't focus on accumulating information, but on how you should live in light of the Word of God. We want to help you apply the insights from Scripture practically and creatively, from your heart as well as your head. At the end of the day, our greatest aim should be allowing the timeless truths from God's Word to transform our lives in Christ.



STUDY NOTES. This brief section provides additional commentary, background, or insights on the passage you'll study in the Learn Together section.

GROW TOGETHER. God wants you to be a part of His Kingdom—to weave your story into His. That will mean change. It will require you to go His way rather than your own. This won't happen overnight, but it should happen steadily. By making small, simple choices, we can begin to change our direction. This is where the Bible's instructions to "be doers of the Word, not just hearers" (James 1:22) comes into play.


Many people skip over this aspect of the Christian life because it's scary, relationally awkward, or simply too much work for their busy schedules. But Jesus wanted all of His disciples to know Him personally, carry out His commands, and help outsiders connect with Him. This doesn't necessarily mean preaching on street corners. It could mean welcoming newcomers, hosting a short-term group in your home, or walking through this study with a friend. In this study, you'll have an opportunity to go beyond Bible study to biblical living.

PRAY TOGETHER. Each week you will close off the meeting with a time of prayer together. We believe that prayer isn't something that goes on the agenda; it **is** the agenda.

MEMORY VERSE. There will be a memory verse of the week that we hope you take the time to memorize. By "hiding God's word in your heart" (Psalm 119:11), we believe that you open yourself up for deeper and more intimate times with the Father.

DAILY DEVOTIONS. Each week on the Daily Devotions pages, we provide Scriptures to read and reflect on between sessions—a month's worth of reflections to keep God's Word near your heart. This provides you with a chance to slow down, read just a small portion of Scripture each day, and reflect and pray through it. You'll then have a chance to journal your response to what you've read. Use this section to seek God on your own throughout the week. This time at home should begin and end with prayer. Don't get in a hurry; take enough time to hear God's direction.

SMALL GROUP AGREEMENT

Our purpose is to talk about what it means to live a God-first life with a few friends.

Group Attendance: To give priority to the group meeting. We will call or email if we will be late or absent. (Completing the Group Calendar will minimize this issue.)

Safe Environment: To help create a safe place where people can be heard and feel loved.

Respect Differences: To be gentle and gracious toward people with different spiritual maturity, personal opinions, temperaments, or "imperfections." We are all a work in progress.

Confidentiality: To keep anything that is shared strictly confidential and within the group, and to avoid sharing improper information about those outside the group.

Encouragement for Growth: Accept one another as we are, while encouraging one another to grow.

Shared Ownership: To remember that every member is a minister and to ensure that each attender will share a small team role or responsibility over time.





What do we do on the first ALL IN Small Group gathering?

Like all fun things in life - have a party! A "get to know you" coffee, dinner, or dessert is a great way to launch a new study.

Where do we find new members for our group?

The best way to grow your group is through personal invitation. Make a list of friends, coworkers, and family members, etc. that you can invite. Then make it a point to talk to at least five people every Sunday. Ask them if they are in an ALL IN Small Group yet, and then invite them to your group if they're not already involved.

No matter how you find members, it's vital

that you stay on the lookout for new people to join your group. All groups tend to go through healthy attrition – the result of moves, releasing new hosts, ministry opportunities, and so forth – and if the group gets too small, it could be at risk of shutting down. If you and your group stay open, you'll be amazed at the people God sends your way. The next person just might become a friend for life. You never know!

How long will this group meet?

The ALL IN Study lasts for 5 weeks, but we'd encourage you to prayerfully consider continuing your group after ALL IN is complete. At the end of this study, each group member may decide if he or she wants to continue on; some groups launch relationships for years to come and others are stepping stones into

another group experience. Either way, enjoy the journey.

Can we do this study on our own?

Absolutely! This may sound crazy, but one of the best ways to do this study is not with a full house but with a few friends. You may choose to gather with another couple who would enjoy some relational time (perhaps going to the movies or having a quiet dinner) and then walking through this study. Jesus will be with you even if there are only two of you (Matthew 18:20).

What if this group is not working for us?

You're not alone! This could be the result of a personality conflict, life stage difference, geographical distance, level of spiritual maturity, or any number of things. Relax. Pray for God's direction, and at the end of this 5-week study, decide whether to continue with this group or find another. You don't typically buy the first car you look at or marry the first person you date, and the same goes with a group. However, don't bail out before the 5 weeks are up – God might have something to teach you. Also, don't run from conflict or prejudge people before you have given them a chance. God is still working in your life, too!

Who is the host?

Most groups have an official host who facilitates the group. But ideally, the group will mature and members will rotate the leadership of meetings. We have discovered that healthy groups rotate hosts/leaders on a regular basis. This model ensures that all members grow, give their unique contribution, and develop their gifts.

This study guide and the Holy Spirit can keep things on track even when you rotate hosts. Christ has promised to be in your midst as you gather. Ultimately, God is your leader each step of the way.

How do we handle the childcare needs in our group?

Very carefully. Seriously, this can be a sensitive issue. We suggest that you empower the group to openly brainstorm solutions. You may try one option that works for a while and then adjust over time. Our favorite approach is for adults to meet in the living room or dining room and to share the cost of a babysitter (or two) who can watch the kids in a different part of the house. This way, parents don't have to be away from their children all evening when their children are too young to be left at home. A second option is to use one home for the kids and a second home (close by or a phone call away) for the adults. A third idea is to rotate the responsibility of providing a lesson or care for the children either in the same home or in another home nearby. This can be an incredible blessing for kids. Finally, the most common solution is to decide that you personally need to have a night to invest in your spiritual lives individually or as a couple and to make your own arrangements for childcare. No matter what decision the group makes, the best approach is to dialogue openly about the solution.

What are you asking me to do?

First and foremost, we are asking that you pray and seek God's leading on what He is asking of you. Prepare your heart to hear Him, and then listen to what He says. Second, engage in an ALL IN Small Group this season – doing LIFE together is better! Make time to engage in personal reflection with God in this ALL IN Study Guide. Talk with your spouse, your family, or others about what this commitment will mean for this next exciting season of your life. We are asking that you make a sacrificial commitment to radical generosity – whatever it is that Jesus leads you to do. Follow His leading.

Finally, we ask that you prepare to be amazed. It is an awesome God that we serve and He is going to show up in huge ways and we anticipate a huge impact from our collective ALL IN commitments. Please mark your calendar for **Commitment Sunday**, **October 24th**, and prepare to experience a life-changing worship service! We are trusting this will be a defining moment for our church and for our faith.

Are there additional ways to give more towards ALL IN?

Be creative as you explore ways you and your family can give towards ALL IN. You might have some stock, property, or other items of that nature. You may have some stored resources that God has blessed you with in the past that He may be calling you to give out of during this time. How long is my commitment?

We are asking that everyone make a year commitment. The fulfillment period for your commitment will begin with our **First Big Give Sunday on November 7th** and will culminate in **November of 2022**.

What if I don't have a job right now? What does that mean for my ALL IN commitment?

ALL IN is about your total, radical, sacrificial generosity to God's mission at Cornerstone. We believe that God calls us to action in times of hardship just as much as He does in times of abundance, and that looks different for every person. We believe God will use ALL IN to bring about a heart change in many as they surrender their lives completely over to God in the area of giving. So that may mean that you are being challenged to sell things, to pick up odd jobs, or even to trust God in faith by making a commitment that you don't quite know how to fulfill right now, but that you believe God will provide for as you seek. We would like everyone to be a part of ALL IN so that we can all be supporting, loving, encouraging, and praying for one another through this spiritually stretching season at Cornerstone.

What if I am severely in debt right now? Am I still supposed to give?

If you are currently seeking to make payments to pay off debt right now, we commend you for making progress on that; and you should continue to do so. Being in debt does not, however, make someone "excused" from giving. Giving isn't about what God wants from you; rather, it's about what God wants for you. So it should be our joy and

privilege to give at all times as sacrifice in discretionary areas.
