"Submit yourselves for the Lord's sake to every authority instituted among men"

2:14-17 Community example: government
2:18-20 Worst (& common) example: slavery
2:21-25 Jesus' example: The Cross
3:1-7 Most relational example: marriage
3:8-17 Most expected example: witnessing

### How we change the world through Jesus

- 1. Know who you are in Jesus (2:16, 2:9)
- 2. Submit to earthly authorities (2:13)
- 3. Endure suffering to break evil (2:20)
- 4. Do "Jesus good" to heal/free people (2:21)
- 5. Declare His hope (2:9, 3:15)



### **1. KNOW WHO YOU ARE IN JESUS**

"Live as free men, but do not use your freedom as a cover-up for evil; live as servants of God" (2:16)

Since you are forgiven and chosen by Jesus to be a royal priesthood, the world's titles, power & approval don't define you or determine your future.



### **2. SUBMIT TO EARTHLY AUTHORITIES**

"Submit yourselves for the Lord's sake to every authority instituted among men" (2:13)

Your first response is to work within the authority structures God has allowed. You spend your energy on God's healing and freedom for the people in it.



#### **3. ENDURE SUFFERING TO BREAK EVIL**

*"if you suffer for doing good and you endure it, this is commendable before God. To this you were <u>called</u>..." (2:20-21)* 

There is a difference between human retaliation and Godly revolution. Jesus demonstrated the way to change people's hearts to truly change the world.



### 4. DO "JESUS GOOD" TO HEAL PEOPLE

"... Christ suffered for you, leaving you an example that you should follow in His steps" (2:21)

You should be creating new life and hope, instead of more death and fear. Your words, actions & attitudes should be like Jesus. You endure to heal (v22-24).



### **5. DECLARE HIS HOPE**

"that you may declare the praises of him..." (2:9)

"be prepared to give ... the reason for the hope that you have" (3:15)

When you suffer well and provide life instead of death, you will become a sign and wonder for the Lord to many people. They will see a hope they want.


