“prepare your minds for action ... set your hope fully on the grace to be given you”

[1 Peter 1:13]

*“if you suffer for doing good and you endure it,
this is commendable before God. To this you
were called, because Christ suffered for you,
leaving you an example”*

to share the reason for our hope.

*“Always be prepared to give an answer to
everyone who asks you to give the reason
for the hope that you have”*

[1 Peter 3:15]

“The end of all things is near. . . Each one should use whatever gift he has received to serve others, faithfully administering God’s grace in its various forms.”

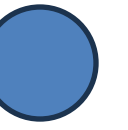
